Regulatory Alert-Ukraine

New RoHS requirements in Ukraine to come into force as of 22nd September 2017.

Following PCS Regulatory Alert in March 2016 regarding new RoHS requirements in Ukraine, it has been confirmed that these new regulations will come into effect on 22nd September 2017. This is in accordance with Decree #139 of the Council of Ministers of Ukraine.

As a reminder, these new requirements are designed to align Ukraine's current Technical Regulations on RoHS with the latest European Directives 2011/65/EU and 2015/863.

The scope of electrical and electronic equipment subject to RoHS requirements will include following equipment types:

- large household appliances;
- small household appliances;
- IT and telecommunications equipment;
- consumer equipment;
- lighting equipment;
- electrical and electronic tools;
- toys, leisure and sports equipment;
- automatic dispensers;
- medical products (including medical products for diagnostics in vitro) monitoring and control instruments;
- other electrical and electronic equipment that does not fall under equipment listed above.

Please see below some important points:

- The Type Approval process is going to be similar to the EMC and Safety Approval schemes currently in place, and it will be possible for manufacturers to obtain a single DoC listing compliance to EMC, Safety and RoHS standards.
- 2) There will be no additional labelling requirements past the EMC/Safety Conformity Mark.
- Manufacturers will have to provide RoHS Conformity Assessment Report to standard EN 50581:2012.
- Products that have already been introduced on Ukrainian market before 22nd September 2017 will not be affected.
- 5) An increase of cost is expected
