Regulatory Update-South Korea

South Korea – Amendments to Labelling Requirements

Further to PCS' Regulatory Update issued on 17th October 2017, the South Korea Regulator, National Radio Research Agency (RRA) issued a Regulation concerning amendments to the labelling methods applicable to Conformity Assessment for Broadcasting Telecommunications Equipment on 5th December 2017. The changes come into effect immediately.

Please find a summary of the main changes below:

- A change to the 'Indication of Broadcasting Communication Equipment' code of the Conformity of Assessment Number from 'MSIP' to 'R', as follows:
